- Plan to apply to graduate school for Fall 2019 or Fall 2020 admission
- Contribute to our diverse student body by **one** or more of the following:
 - Come from an educational, cultural, or geographic background that is underrepresented
 - Have demonstrated commitment to diversity in the academic, professional, or civic realm
 - Have experienced financial hardship as a result of family economic circumstances
 - Are first-generation U.S. citizens or first generation in family to graduate from a four year college

Additionally, strong candidates will possess the following:

- Research experience in a laboratory setting
- Strong academic record and motivation to pursue biomedical research
